Treasurer: All bills have been paid. The current balance is \$8,110 in our accounts. Pending bills to be paid are Spirit Wear purchases, Winter Sports banquet and recent team/AD requests noted below.

NEW BUSINESS: Stefani asked for someone to be at the door to take donations for both this coming Friday and the 12th's basketball games. Several indicated that they would be there but she will include that with her concessions email.

Claudia Scherillo—Athletic Director

- Banners for our region need to be updated/replaced. Wilson Wong has been contacted and has quoted a price of \$35. He can do the championship banners for \$45. She will talk to him about how we can get them here.
- She requested \$892.00 for sports pins and chenille wildcat letters. The chenille wildcats cost \$18 each and there's a break down on the pins. The price for the chenille wildcat is merely seed money because the students will pay for them. A motion was made, seconded and a unanimous vote carried.
- There are three teams that are requesting funds:
 - Duke Marlow requested \$499.99 to go towards an L-shaped safety net to go with the batting machine. Stefani asked if DoDDS will ever provide this, and Duke said probably not. A motion was made, seconded and a unanimous vote carried.
 - Vito Vitulli needs \$499.99 to go towards Europeans. A motion was made, seconded and a unanimous vote carried.
 - Kathryn Osborne requested \$499.99 for Cheer to go to Europeans. It was asked if they have done fundraising and she said that they had. A motion was made, seconded and a unanimous vote carried.

- Ron Zimmerman—the swim team won at Southern Division Championships at Sigonella. Feb 13-14 the Naples Tiger Sharks are going to Eindhoven, Netherlands for the European Forces Swim League (EFSL) Championships, competing against 18 other swim teams.

Claudia mentioned that it's very important that everyone knows that if someone helps with a fundraiser before the final team is announced it does not guarantee a spot on the team. There was a lot of discussion on fundraising under BC's and it was decided the best venue would be under the SAF as all monies will go directly towards the team.
